- **Wear your helmet!** – No helmet, no building.



- **Wear sturdy shoes!**
– No running – safety comes first.



- **Work as a team!** – Building together is better.
Look out for one another – do not throw or kick objects.



- **Do not lift large items onto the roof**
Only roof tiles may be taken onto the roof.

Everything that belongs on the construction site stays there.

Everything outside the construction site stays outside. The children's construction site is not a place for tables, chairs, or picnic blankets.

Take good care of tools and materials.



- **Rubbish does not belong on the construction site.** – Please put all waste in the bin.

- Only one child at a time may jump



- Do not bring toys or other objects onto the trampoline



- Do not use the trampoline when it is wet or raining, as it may become slippery



- Maximum load: 170 kg (375 lbs)

Go-Kart Safety Rules

So everyone can drive safely and have fun!



The go-karts are free to use – donations are welcome! Rental hours: Saturday & Sunday, 12:00 PM–6:30 PM (last rental: 6:00 PM) A deposit is required for rental (e.g. ID card or driver's license)



- Children must be accompanied by an adult to rent a go-kart.



- Maximum riding time: 30 minutes per ride. After your ride, please return the go-kart to the station and only drive in the designated area.



- Do not bump into other go-karts or objects. Careful and considerate driving is required at all times.



- Maximum rider weight: 80 kg (176 lbs) per go-kart.



- Use the seats for sitting and do not drive while standing.

Failure to follow these rules will result in the loss of go-kart privileges. Parents or legal guardians are responsible for any damages. Use at your own risk.

Welcome to Gut Königsmühle

To help everyone stay safe and enjoy their visit!

General Rules:

- opening hours (unless otherwise communicated): **10:00 AM – 7:00 PM** The café is open Friday to Sunday and on public holidays from 11:00 AM – 7:00 PM During school holidays, the farm and café are open on weekdays from 4:00 PM onwards
- Use at your own risk.

Treat people and animals with respect:

- Dogs must be kept on a leash and are not allowed in the sand areas.
- Do not feed, chase, scare, or throw things at the animals.
- Please **treat play equipment** with care (e.g. sand toys, balls) and return it after use: Balls belong in the storage box on the football field. Sand toys belong in the designated wooden boxes or in the indoor sandbox.
- Please **dispose of all rubbish in the bins** provided. Do not hang on the football goals, climb in the indoor sandbox, or climb onto the roofs of the playhouses.

Football may not be played on the football field while wearing studded or cleated shoes. Drones, with or without cameras, are not permitted.

Visitors may bring snacks and drinks. However, once a plate is required for consumption, it is no longer considered a snack.

- Bringing food from, or having food delivered by, other restaurants or catering businesses is not permitted.
 - Barbecues and open fires are prohibited.
 - Urinating in public is prohibited.
 - **Smoking** (including e-cigarettes and shisha) **is only permitted in the designated smoking areas:** at the café, at the main entrance gate
- No drug use.

Parents or legal guardians are liable for any damages caused by children in their care.

Vandalism will be prosecuted.

Toilets

Café toilets: Open during café opening hours.

Media Room toilets: Open during playground opening hours.

Workshop toilets: Open in good weather during playground opening hours.

Young children must use the toilets accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Vehicles:

- No bicycles, e-scooters, or similar vehicles may be ridden on the farm grounds – please dismount. Bicycles must be parked in the designated bicycle racks. Do not park them near the playground, café, or walkways.

Visitor parking on the farm grounds is not permitted. Please follow all parking signs.

Visitor parking is available on Saturdays and Sundays at the IKEA car park (Gate A), Ellinghauser Str. 213, during the season only. Please follow posted instructions.

During this time, the parking spaces directly in front of the farm are reserved for visitors with disabilities or mobility impairments (blue or orange parking permit required).

Group Visits:

- Groups of 10 or more people must register in advance. Use of the farm is free of charge for private visitors only.

Educational institutions and social organisations must always register via: anmeldung@helpandhope-stiftung.com

Private groups are welcome; however, parties and buffets are not permitted. Reservations for private celebrations (birthdays) can be made via: cafe@helpandhope-stiftung.com

Please note: Outside food is not permitted. Catering must be provided through the farm café. Rearranging or combining seating areas is not permitted.
